(MUST HAVE 2 OR MORE ENTRIES IN THE DIVISION)

The age of handlers/horses must be as of January 1, 2023.

Removing the bridle or detaching the reins from the bit before unhitching the horse from the vehicle, anywhere on the grounds, will result in instant disqualification.

The Show Committee reserves the right to combine, move, or adjust the show schedule, as they deem necessary, to run a smooth show. Classes with less than 2 participants may be combined into another division. **No one is to approach the judge at any time for any reason. You must see the show steward with any disputes. The decision of the Buxmont board of directors is final in the case of any dispute.** All show rules of the Buxmont Riding Club will be followed. Classes will be conducted using the rules of the American Driving Society as a guide. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry or excuse any entry they deem unsafe. Under penalty of elimination there shall be no schooling or walking a horse over any of the obstacle courses.

Open Very Small Equine (VSE) Single/Pairs – Open to any animal under 39”- VSE

- 1T/1W. Turnout/ Working – Judged as one class, ribbons given out as 2 classes, one for turnout, then one for working.
2. Reinsmanship-
3. Cones – Timed Obstacles
4. Your Route/My Route

Open Pony Single/Pairs – Small ponies - Open to any animal over 39”and under 14.2 hands.

- 5T/5W. Turnout/ Working – Judged as one class, ribbons given out as 2 classes, one for turnout, then one for working.
6. Reinsmanship-
7. Cones – Timed Obstacles
8. Your Route/My Route

Open Single Horse Single/Pairs - Open to any animal over 14.2 hands

- 9T/9W. Turnout/ Working – Judged as one class, ribbons given out as 2 classes, one for turnout, then one for working.
10. Reinsmanship-
11. Cones – Timed Obstacles
12. Your Route/My Route

Novice Whip Pony/Horse, Single/Pairs - Open to whips that have not won more than 6 blue ribbons in Buxmont Driving classes or three blue ribbons at ADS recognized shows prior to the current season, driving any animal.

- 13T/13W. Turnout/ Working –Judged as one class, ribbons given out as 2 classes, one for turnout, then one for working.
14. Reinsmanship-
15. Cones – Timed Obstacles
16. Your Route/My Route

Junior to Drive Pony/Horse, Single/Pair- Under the age of 18 years old – In classes for juniors, when applicable, emphasis should be placed on manners and the suitability for being driven by a junior. At all times while on a carriage, all Juniors must wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds current ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carry the SEI tag.

- 17T/17W. Turnout/ Working –Judged as one class, ribbons given out as 2 classes, one for turnout, then one for working.
18. Reinsmanship-
19. Cones – Timed Obstacles
20. Your Route/My Route

Ladies to Drive Pony/Horse, Single/Pair - In classes for ladies, when applicable, emphasis should be placed on manners and the suitability for being driven by a lady.

21. Ladies to Drive Class

Carriage Dog - Judged primarily on suitability of the dog to serve as a companion (maximum one dog per vehicle). To be judged both ways in the arena at a walk, slow trot and working trot.

22. Carriage Dog Class

Gentlemen to Drive Pony/Horse, Single/Pair – Entries are judged primarily on the suitability of the turnout for a gentleman with emphasis on manners.

23. Gentleman to Drive Class

Classes will start in the Main Ring at 10:00 AM.

All Cones-Timed Obstacle classes will start in Cones Ring at 10:00am. Finish your cones -timed obstacles **BEFORE** lunch.

All My Route/Your Route classes will start in Cones Ring **AFTER** lunch.

Prior to the starting time, the Cones Ring will be open for walking the course - by humans only!

Under penalty of elimination there shall be no schooling or walking a horse over any of the obstacle courses.
